Jarboe Russell is author of *The New York Times* bestseller, *The Train to Crystal City*, the story of a secret American internment camp in South Texas during World War II. Japanese, German, and Italian immigrants and their American-born children were shipped to the camp and used in a government prisoner exchange program.

Combining big-picture World War II history with a little-known event in American history that has long been kept quiet, *The Train to Crystal City* reveals the war-time hysteria against the Japanese and Germans in America, the secrets of FDR's tactics to rescue high-profile POWs in Germany and Japan, and how the definition of American citizenship changed under the pressure of war.

The book received the Texas Institute of Letters Prize for Best Book of Nonfiction in 2015.
